2023 FINANCE UPDATE

Kochenderfer UMC has done many wonderful things in the 2022 year! We celebrated 150 years as a congregation, held Vacation Bible School and numerous children's events, hired a new Youth Director, andre-envisioned our ministry teams.

We gave scholarships to 6 summer campers, ran our Christian Day Care for 254 days of the year, shared our Sunday services by live stream, and kept our grass mowed and the bushes trimmed. We supported our Boy and Cub Scouts events for 52 weeks of the year, remodeled our old pavilion into a beautiful classroom, and tuned our pianos. We hosted funeral meals, collected donations, gave back to our community, and opened our

doors to welcome the families of our Day Care children. We are glad to have passed the milestone in July to now less than a half million dollars left for our CLC mortgage. We rejoice that the Day Care has received several grants enabling us to stay open and keep our excellent staff.

While we are delighted to celebrate these activities, we are also concerned that the finance accounts have been dropping to lower levels than we have ever seen. Our budget for 2023 is as trimmed down as we can make it. Here a few numbers:

- \$122.91 The average donation given to KUMC
- \$4,214 Average weekly offering in Oct & Nov 2022
- \$31,585 Average monthly cost of building and operations
- 254 Number of days the Day Care is open each year
- 78 Average attendance on Sunday mornings
- 13.25 Average number of hours per weekday the building is in use
- \$25,190 Expected utility bills for 2023 (water, heat, electric, trash)

We want to prayerfully consider

how we at Kochenderfer can continue to serve, celebrate, host, support, and keep being a solid ministry for the next 10 years. We may have to find new ways of doing things or find entirely new things to do. Some events may change or cease; some new technology may help us connect with our community; some new people may bring new ideas.

Here are a few ideas we have for the future:

- Renovate the parsonage space for use as meeting area, offices, and prayer group gatherings.
- Replace the carpet in the CLC, and write new prayers in our foundations.
- Update the sanctuary's pew pads, aisle carpet, and chancel platform.
- Host weekly summer events for safe, positive, healthy family outdoor time

What would you add to this list?
What spaces can we use in new ways? What items can we repurpose? As we begin 2023, we want to be in regular, careful, constant prayer. We invite you to pray together and alone, aloud and silently, with eyes closed and eyes open. Become more aware of God's heart and God's hands in our midst.
