With this month's newsletter, I want to share with you about a project that Kochenderfer Church's leadership have been taking. In 2022, the United Methodists of Eastern Pennsylvania began a program called "Pathways." Our leadership determined to begin this work of receiving spiritual and strategical guidance from a facilitator assigned to us. Over the course of the last year, we have been assessing and learning about what it means to be a fruitful congregation.

Our specific focus was initially in the area of making new disciples as one of the core principles of our Mission Statement is: "Invite to an intimate, committed relationship with God." However, after a year working on this pathway, we discerned that it is important for us to make our focus on sustainability. This pathway's focus is on the ability to have the finances for a sustainable long-term future for our congregation's ministry and mission.

This pathway is necessary because we are still paying down the mortgage that was taken 20 years ago to build the CLC extension of the

church. The monthly cost of this mortgage has gone up, as have the monthly cost of just about every other operating expense. In October 2003, the ground breaking for the extension began and the completion of that work was in May 2004. The Lead Team and I believe that the past 20 years of ministry that has happened in the CLC is worthy of celebrating. And thus, we are going to celebrate over the next 7 months. And we are going to look forward to what God can do in the future. We don't yet know where this is taking us. But I have faith that wherever God is taking us is going to be exciting and a renewal of the strength this congregation has!
